The second picture shows the east side of the campus where the portable classrooms USED to be located. The portable classrooms have been moved to Lockney ISD. Lockney ISD purchased the portable classrooms to give them some temporary classroom space while they re-build their high school that was destroyed by fire about a month ago.

The east side of the campus is also the location we are looking at to put the new entrance, parking lot, drop-off/pick-up location at DeShazo Elementary. The Board of Trustees voted Monday to hire an architect to draw up the plans to put a new entrance, parking lot, and drop-off/pick-up location there. Included in the proposal would be re-location of the principal's office and library. The new principal's office will include room for a reception area, counselor, nurse, and conference room.
